Global investments to renewables



By early 2010, more than 100 countries had some type of policy target and/or promotion policy related to renewable energy (compared with 55 countries in early 2005)

Despite economic recession in 2009 more than \$150 billion was invested in new renewable energy capacity and manufacturing plants (up from just \$30 billion in 2004)

Renewables comprised fully one quarter of global power capacity from all sources and delivered 18 percent of global electricity supply in 2009.

Investment in new renewable power capacity in both 2008 and 2009 represented over half of total global investment in new power generation.
